I see man as a very crooked figure indeed, and the medium of dance as at its most powerful when infused with a crooked edge. "Crooked Figure" comes from the prologue to Shakespeare's Henry the Fifth. In that instance it describes a curved number, zero or cipher, all of which have interesting connotations. With this Crooked Figure, I embark on a new search for meaning in my artistic practice, even in the naming of things....




