

## Archives publiques du Canada

La division des manuscrits possède plusieurs fonds ayant un contenu qui intéresse la danse. La Collection des arts d'interprétation regroupe en 32 volumes des programmes, communiqués de presse et autres documents publicitaires classés par villes canadiennes. Les archives de certains organismes ou de particuliers contiennent de nombreuses références à la danse. Le Groupe de la Place Royale, Neta Toumine et Celia Franca ont déposé une partie de leurs archives à la division des manuscrits. Les fonds de la Conférence canadienne des arts et de la Fondation canadienne offrent une documentation abondante en danse. Enfin, les archives de John Stephen Hirsch, Thomas Best Hendry et Louis Honoré Bourdon présentent un contenu susceptible d'intéresser les historiens de la danse au Canada.

La division des photographies possède une collection de quelque 70 photos concernant la danse. Cette documentation intéresse peu la danse théâtrale car elle se concentre sur les groupes ethniques et la danse sociale. Quelques photos remontent au dix-neuvième siècle comme celle du bal masqué donné par Lord Dufferin le 23 février ~~1876~~ 1876.

La division de l'iconographie a répertorié un peu plus d'une vingtaine d'illustrations sur la danse dont nécessairement les gravures de George Heriot publiées au début du siècle dernier. La documentation iconographique réunie illustre la danse sociale et celle des Indiens d'Amérique. Les Archives ont

indéré la collection iconographique de C.W. Jefferys  
ainsi que le Canadian Illustrated News.

Les Archives publiques possèdent également une  
section audio-visuelle qui comprend des films et  
rubans magnétoscopiques. Le fichier de cette collec-  
tion signale quelque cinquante enregistrements  
vidéo d'une durée variable dont certains ont un  
caractère historique comme le premier festival de  
ballet au Canada <sup>(1948)</sup> ou le duel entre Serge Lifar et  
le Marquis de Cuevas en 1958.
