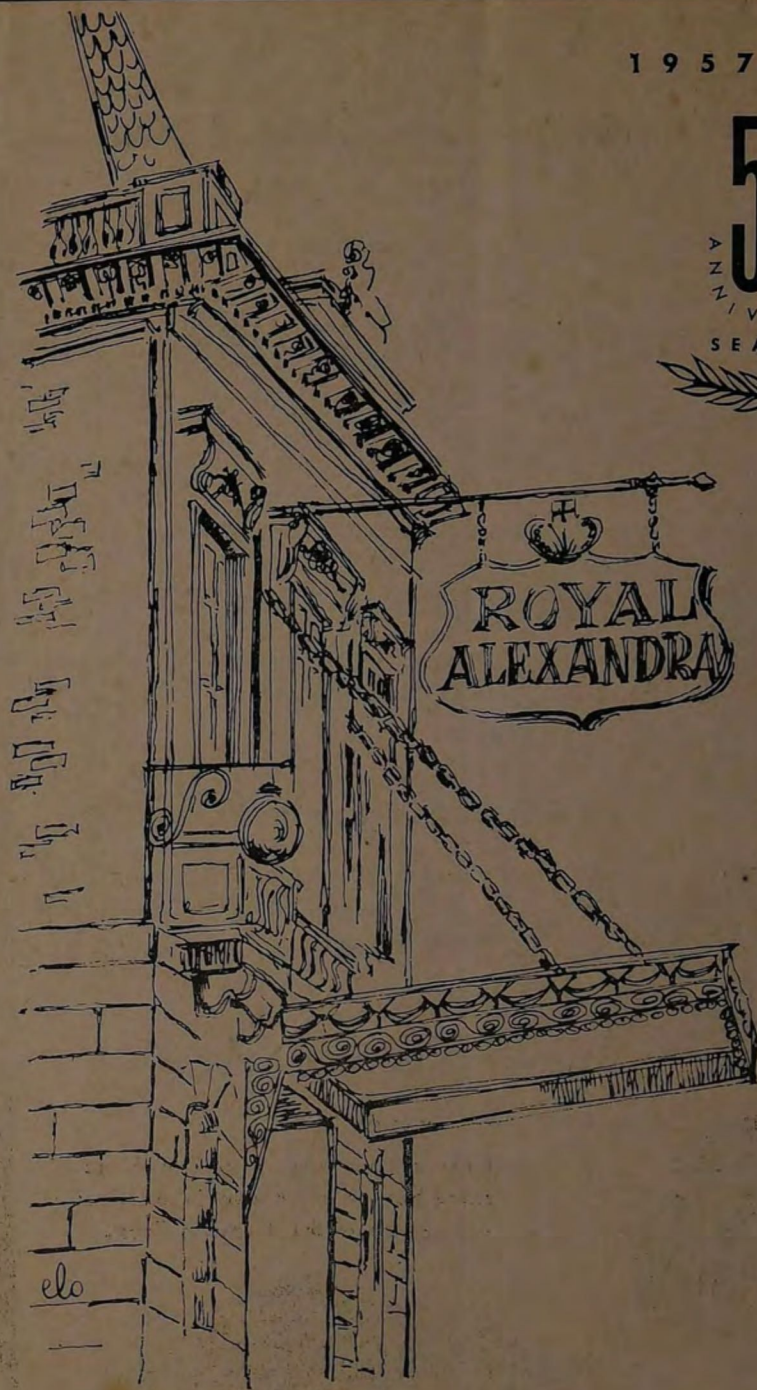

**"MY FUR LADY" ESTABLISHES
NEW RECORD AT ROYAL ALEXANDRA**

That musical, mythical, satire extraordinaire, "My Fur Lady", will erupt once more on the stage of the Royal Alexandra when it returns for a two-week engagement commencing Monday, April 21st. This will be "My Fur Lady's" fifth visit to Toronto, setting a new record for the Royal Alex. When the gay spoof of Canadian mores and customs completes its fifth visit, it will have played for eight weeks this season, surpassing the previous long-run record of six weeks held by "South Pacific."

"My Fur Lady" returns to Toronto following its triumphant tour of the Maritime provinces, and precedes its western journey which is

scheduled to wind up at Vancouver in July, in time to help celebrate that city's centennial.

Wherever "My Fur Lady" has appeared, it has been enthusiastically received by the press and public. It has created long-run records in many of the cities visited. At Montreal, where it is currently appearing at Le Theatre de la Comedie Canadienne, the first English-language attraction to be invited to Gratien Gelinus' new theatre, it will have chalked up a record fifteen weeks in that city. In Ottawa where it returns next week, it will have achieved a record of eighteen performances. Kingston, ordinarily a one or two night stand, will have played host to "My Fur Lady" for seven performances.

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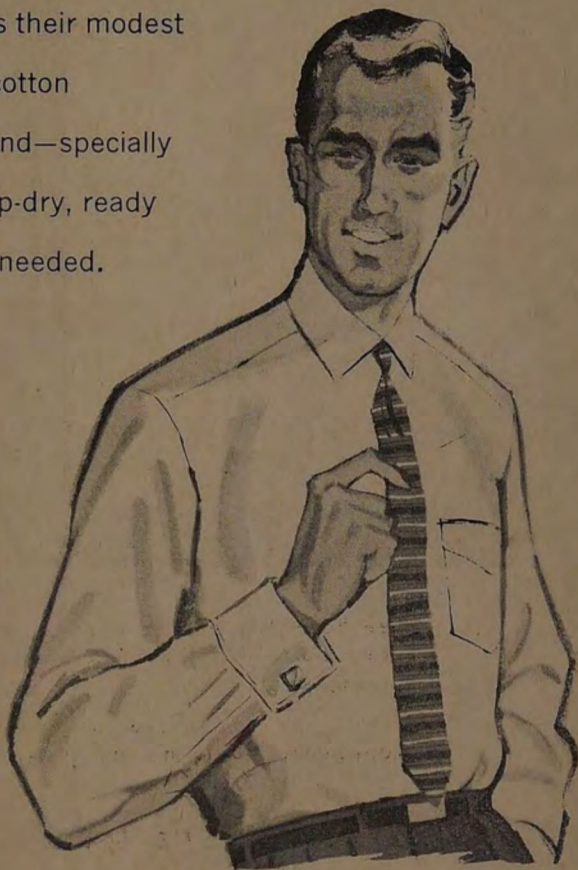
